

These Terms and Conditions apply to all participants of Project 8 UK, which is operated by The8House Pty Ltd (hereinafter referred to as “the Producer”), and by submitting an application, by accepting a place, or by making any payment toward the program, all participants and, where applicable, their parent or legal guardian in cases where the participant is under the age of 18 years, expressly acknowledge, agree to, and accept all of the following terms, conditions, policies, procedures, and requirements as outlined below, including but not limited to provisions relating to program acceptance, payment terms, refund and cancellation policies, schedule changes, participant conduct, health and physical risk acknowledgement, personal property responsibilities, media release, intellectual property rights, social media participation, safeguarding and child protection, travel and accommodation responsibilities, limitation of liability, force majeure, and any other provisions or stipulations mentioned herein or reasonably implied by the program and the conduct of the Producer, its faculty, staff, and associated partners.

1. **Program Acceptance**

Project 8 UK is an application-based dance intensive. Submission of an application does not, in any way, guarantee acceptance to the program, and successful applicants will only receive an official offer of placement once their application has been reviewed, evaluated, and approved at the sole discretion of Project 8 UK. A participant's place in the program is secured only once the required deposit payment has been received and processed in full according to the payment instructions and deadlines specified by the Producer. Project 8 UK expressly reserves the right to decline or withdraw an offer of placement at its absolute discretion, including but not limited to situations where a participant has failed to meet deadlines, provided incomplete information, or otherwise failed to satisfy the requirements of the application process. Places are strictly limited and may, under the sole discretion of the Producer, be offered to another applicant in cases where payment deadlines are not met or if a participant's application is otherwise deemed ineligible.

2. **Payment Terms**

To secure participation in Project 8 UK, a non-refundable deposit is required upon acceptance. The remaining balance must be paid in full by the final payment date specified by the Producer in official communications. Failure to meet payment deadlines may result in the forfeiture of the participant's place in the program, with no refund or compensation provided. Payment plans may be offered at the sole discretion of Project 8 UK and must be adhered to in full once agreed. Failure to comply with agreed payment plans may result in immediate cancellation of participation, forfeiture of previously paid amounts, and revocation of program access.

3. **Refund & Cancellation Policy**

**Participant Withdrawal:** If a participant chooses to withdraw from the program at any point, the deposit remains strictly non-refundable under any circumstances. Any additional payments may be refunded only at the sole discretion of Project 8 UK, in exceptional circumstances, and upon submission of a written request. Refunds will not be granted for reasons including, but not limited to, scheduling conflicts, change of personal circumstances, injury occurring outside of program hours, or travel complications. Participants are strongly encouraged to obtain adequate travel and personal insurance to cover unforeseen circumstances where refunds are not provided.

**Event Cancellation or Postponement:** Project 8 UK reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to cancel, postpone, or reschedule the event due to circumstances beyond reasonable control, including but not limited to venue closure, illness or travel disruption of faculty, government restrictions, public health emergencies, or other force majeure events. In such cases, Project 8 UK may offer, at its sole discretion, a rescheduled date for the event, event credit, or a partial or full refund. The Producer accepts no responsibility or liability for external expenses including, without limitation, flights, accommodation, or travel booked independently by participants.

4. **Schedule Changes**

Project 8 UK reserves the right, without notice, to modify class schedules, faculty members, program structure, and choreography assignments. Changes may occur for reasons including illness, travel disruption, or unforeseen circumstances. Every reasonable effort will be made to maintain the quality and integrity of the program, though participants acknowledge that such modifications may be necessary and agree to abide by any revised schedule or structure.

5. **Participant Conduct**

Participants are expected to behave in a professional, respectful, and cooperative manner throughout the program. Project 8 UK maintains a zero-tolerance policy regarding bullying, harassment, discrimination, disruptive or inappropriate behaviour, and disrespect toward faculty, staff, or fellow participants. Failure to adhere to these standards may result in immediate removal from the program, without any refund, compensation, or recourse.

6. **Health & Physical Risk Acknowledgement**

Dance training is physically demanding and inherently carries risks of injury. By participating, dancers acknowledge that they are medically and physically fit to undertake intensive dance training and voluntarily assume all risks associated with participation. Project 8 UK, its producers, faculty, staff, and affiliated partners accept no liability for injuries sustained during the program except where required by law. Participants are responsible for maintaining their own physical health, obtaining relevant medical insurance, and covering any medical costs arising from participation.

7. **Personal Property**

Participants are responsible for the security, safety, and care of their personal belongings. Project 8 UK and its staff accept no liability for loss, theft, or damage to personal property, including but not limited to costumes, dance equipment, personal electronics, clothing, or travel items, under any circumstances during the program.

8. **Media Release**

Project 8 UK may photograph, film, and record classes, rehearsals, performances, and behind-the-scenes content. By participating, dancers grant Project 8 UK and The8House Pty Ltd perpetual, worldwide rights to use their image, voice, likeness, and performances in promotional materials, social media, advertising campaigns, marketing materials, and future Project 8 UK promotions. No compensation will be provided, and participants waive any right to review or approve finished materials.

9. **Intellectual Property**

All choreography created during Project 8 UK remains the intellectual property of the respective choreographer. Participants may not reproduce, perform, teach, film, or distribute choreography created during the program without explicit permission from the choreographer and Project 8 UK. Unauthorized recording or distribution is strictly prohibited.

10. **Social Media Participation**

Participants are encouraged to share their experience on personal social media platforms, but must adhere to restrictions regarding choreography and other sensitive content. The Producer reserves the right to request removal of content that compromises safety, intellectual property, or program integrity.

11. **Safeguarding & Child Protection**

Project 8 UK is committed to providing a safe environment. Faculty working with participants under 18 will hold appropriate clearances, and

participants under 18 must have written consent from a parent or guardian. Participation acknowledges physical activity risks.

12. **Travel & Accommodation**

Participants are responsible for arranging and paying for travel, accommodation, and local transport unless otherwise specified. The Producer accepts no responsibility for travel disruptions or associated costs.

13. **Limitation of Liability**

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Project 8 UK, The8House Pty Ltd, its directors, employees, faculty, contractors, and partners shall not be liable for personal injury, loss or damage to property, travel disruptions, or indirect or consequential loss. Participation is undertaken entirely at the participant's own risk.

14. **Force Majeure**

Project 8 UK shall not be liable for failure to perform obligations resulting from events beyond reasonable control including natural disasters, war, government restrictions, public health emergencies, venue closures, or transport disruption.

15. **Agreement**

By applying for or participating in Project 8 UK, participants and their parent/guardian confirm that they have read, understood, and agree to abide by all of the above Terms & Conditions, acknowledge the risks associated with participation, and accept all policies, procedures, and requirements set forth by Project 8 UK and The8House Pty Ltd.
